**CALL TO ORDER**

Ms. Stephanie U'Ren with ODMHSAS called the December 18, 2008 Task Force meeting to order and declared a quorum was not present. Ms. U'Ren was Ms. Jessica Hawkins' representative in her absence. Copies of the December 18, 2008 meeting minutes were distributed.

**WELCOME**

Ms. U'Ren welcomed everyone to the meeting and informed everyone they could not take action on agenda items today because a quorum was not present.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING MEMBERSHIP UPDATE AND TASK FORCE BY-LAWS**

Ms. U'Ren informed the Task Force that the Governor's Office has approved the Task Force to change the Executive Order so additional seats can be added. All names have been submitted to Ms. Hawkins and forwarded to Mr. Steven Buck. At this time, we are waiting on official appointee letters from the Governor's Office. The Task Force could not approve the by-laws because no quorum was present.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING PRIORITIZATION FOR ACTION ON TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATIONS**

The Task Force discussed the role to have with some the recommendations. There were discussions to support the ABLE Commission in getting

data/information for a rule change for Alcopops. At the moment, ABLE has purchased items to be sent for testing to see if there's distilled alcohol mix. Ms. Stacy Potter informed the Task Force there's no actual language on social host at the moment. There were other discussions to strengthen laws on keg registration language, increase tax on 3.2 beer, ban the sale of cold singles, and start releasing information and statistics (have a news release every month). The Task Force also discussed openly supporting the social host/health education bill to whatever capacity.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (SAMHSA) STATEWIDE UNDERAGE DRINKING VIDEO PROJECT UPDATE**

The video committee decided to do 3 short videos: youth video, reducing youth access, and a marketing video. The youth has created a sub-committee.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING LEGISLATIVE UPDATE**

Ms. Potter informed the Task Force that Senator Leftwich authored 708 Senate Bill – Low Point Beer. Once language of social host is ready, it will be distributed to the Task Force.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (SAMHSA) STATEWIDE UNDERAGE DRINKING VIDEO PROJECT UPDATE**

Ms. Hawkins provided an update about the project for those who were not at the last Task Force meeting; she also stated there's no new work being done at this time.
