CALL TO ORDER

Ms. Teresa Ryan called the May Governor's Task Force on the Prevention of Underage Drinking meeting to order at 1:34 p.m. and declared a quorum was not present.

WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Ms. Ryan welcomed the members and the guests.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The April meeting minutes were distributed and reviewed by the members. No action was taken.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE PLACE OF LAST DRINK PRESENTATION

Ms. Lenae Clements provided a brief presentation on the Place of Last Drink. The Place of Last Drink is information collected from DUI Assessors. The data collection is currently in the preliminary stages and ODMHSAS is currently working on refining the information to receive more detailed information. The Place of Last Drink data will be provided to the Area Prevention Resource Centers (APRCs) to see which types of establishments are selling to intoxicated individuals. The APRCs will receive the name of the establishment and the date the establishment sold to the intoxicated person. The information will be provided to the APRCs on a quarterly basis. The APRCs will use the data collected to target alcohol compliance checks and Responsible Beverage Service and Sales (RBSS) trainings. No action was taken.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING 2M2L REPORT

Ms. Hilary Gibson provided the group with the 2M2L report. The rural 2M2L Academy will be held at Western Hills Guest Ranch in Wagoner from July 19 – 22, 2010. The urban 2M2L Academy will be held at the National Center for Employee Development in Norman from July 27 – 30, 2010.

2M2L is currently in the process of creating a variety of different resources for 2M2L Clubs across the state. E-learning opportunities are currently being developed and will debut in September of 2010. A 2M2L Activity Guide is also currently being developed and will be available in September of 2010.

Seven members of the 2M2L Youth Council will be attending the National Students Against Destructive Decisions (SADD) Conference. The conference will be held in Orlando, Florida and will be from June 26 – 30, 2010.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE OPPA REPORT

Ms. Stacy Potter announced that the OPPA Retreat will be held at Sarkeys in Norman on June 3, 2010. The first part of the training will consist of a teambuilding component and the second part of the training will be OPPA's planning session.

Mark Attanasi of the Oklahoma Drug and Alcohol Professional Counselor Board (ODAPCA) would like to work with OPPA on a huge conference for substance abuse prevention in the future.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING 2010 UNDERAGE DRINKING LEGISLATION

Ms. Potter provided an update on some of the legislature bills. Senator Leftwich's party bus bill was submitted by CCR; Representative Duncan's bill passed the House and Senate (HB2297), OPPA will watch the language; it strengthens the penalties. HB2348 – was approved by the Governor; Representative Steele's Smoke-free Bill on School Campuses passed.

NEW BUSINESS

Ms. Gayle Jones is currently working on an education grant, which is due on June 7, 2010. The grant is in the amount of \$125,000 and would help benefit the schools.

Ms. Ryan announced that the Injury Prevention Sub-Committee will be meeting this upcoming Friday on May 21, 2010. It was also announced that the Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) Fact Sheet will be coming out in the upcoming weeks.
