





ODMHSAS Has Cut Administrative Overhead and Increased Operational Efficiency/Effectiveness


- The department's administrative overhead is less than 3% and agency FTEs have decreased significantly

In Fact, Overall ODMHSAS Salaries Are Significantly Lower Than Other Oklahoma State Agencies

- Even with physician’s salaries included, ODMHSAS’ overall average salaries are far less than those at other state agencies (and in most cases employee numbers are fewer)



ODMHSAS Has Been Forced to Slash \$9.8 Million From the Current Fiscal Year Budget

Category	Amount Cut
Direct Cut to ODMHSAS (Administrative Costs, Personnel and Services)	\$4,400,000
Postpone the Expansion of New Mental Health Courts	1,500,000
Cut to Safety Net Services	1,300,000
LBHP Changes	1,200,000
Postpone the Expansion of Systems of Care	1,000,000
Prevention Services	400,000
Total Cut	\$9,800,000



Projected Impact of Additional Cuts

Additional Revenue Failure (Projected Impact)

For every additional 1% cut to the current FY2016 budget:

- A **\$3.16 million cut** to prevention, treatment and recovery services
- At least **1,580 Oklahomans** will lose services



Projected Impact of Additional Cuts

Additional Oklahomans will Lose Services if Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Services are Cut Further in FY2017

	<u>Oklahomans Estimated to Lose Services</u>
Unfunded Maintenance Request	(at least) 2,200
10% Cut (plus unfunded maintenance)	(at least) 16,042

- Projections are based on an average cost per person for ODMHSAS services. Cuts could also impact available federal funding and potentially reduce treatment funds by an estimated up to \$100M (and subsequent provider billing).
