Valarie Raine, Esq. is the Director of Drug Court Programs. She assists New York's Court System in developing drug courts and oversees national drug court technical assistance projects supported by the Bureau of Justice Assistance. She is currently President of the New York Association of Drug Treatment Court Professionals and is a former board member for the National Association of Drug Court Professionals. Ms. Raine taught a course on problem-solving justice at Fordham Law School, served as faculty for the National Drug Court Institute, and presents frequently at conferences. From 1996 to 2000 she was Project Director of the Brooklyn Treatment Court, where she helped develop and manage New York City's first drug treatment court. Previously, she worked at the Legal Aid Society, Criminal Defense Division in Kings County, appointed attorney-in-charge in 1994. Ms. Raine is a graduate of Hunter College and the University of Virginia Law School.
