EXECUTIVE ORDER 2002-08

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Oklahoma Statutes in 25 O.S. Section 82.1, hereby order the following dates be observed as holidays by the State of Oklahoma in 2003:

Wednesday	January 1	New Year's Day
Monday	January 20	Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
Monday	February 17	Presidents' Day
Monday	May 26	Memorial Day
Friday	July 4	Independence Day
Monday	September 1	Labor Day
Tuesday	November 11	Veterans Day
Thursday & Friday	November 27 & 28	Thanksgiving
Thursday & Friday	December 25 & 26	Christmas

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Office of Personnel Management who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
