I am pleased to announce that, effective November 4, 2002, applicants for state employment may test at the Tulsa office of the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission (OESC), at the following location:

Tulsa, OK 74120**

This location, combined with the 22 Oklahoma CareerTech campuses statewide and the Office of Personnel Management in Oklahoma City, brings to 24 the total number of available test sites for the general public.

As is the case with our other statewide testing centers, applicants wishing to test in Tulsa must have been approved for testing prior to appearing for the examination. Each applicant who mails in an approvable application requiring a written examination receives a scheduling letter from the Office of Personnel Management. This letter serves as the admission to the examinations at any of our statewide locations.
