L Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Oklahoma Statutes in 25 O.S. 1998, Section 82.1, hereby order the following dates be observed as holidays by the State of Oklahoma in 2002:

Monday	January 21	Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
Monday	February 18	Presidents' Day
Monday	May 27	Memorial Day
Thursday	July 4	Independence Day
Monday	September 2	Labor Day
Monday	November 11	Veterans Day
Thursday & Friday	November 28 & 29	Thanksgiving
Wednesday	December 25	Christmas

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Office of Personnel Management who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
