EXECUTIVE ORDER 99-23

I, Frank Keating, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Oklahoma Statutes in 25 O.S. 1998, Section 82.1, hereby order the following dates be observed as holidays by the State of Oklahoma in 2000:

Friday	December 31, 1999	New Year's Day
Monday	January 17	Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday
Monday	February 21	Presidents' Day
Monday	May 29	Memorial Day
Tuesday	July 4	Independence Day
Monday	September 4	Labor Day
Friday	November 10	Veterans Day
Thursday & Friday	November 23 & 24	Thanksgiving
Monday	December 25	Christmas

This executive order shall be forwarded to the Director of the Office of Personnel Management who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
