1. Call to Order and Roll Call*

4. Director's Report

Agency activities report...... (Josh Smith reporting)

The Director updated the Board regarding ongoing activities:

Intoxilyzer 9000 updates: Software Development and engineering continues at CMI, Inc. They submitted firmware to the agency to evaluate. We completed the first evaluation, and we are awaiting the corrections.

IDAP Program: Current average enrollments total 250 per month.

5. Overview of current interlock test and retest sequences

The Director gave an overview of the current retest sequences for the ignition interlock devices in Oklahoma. The Board asked the Director to see how often interlock users experience a retest violation. The Director reported he would try to gather up that information and report back at the next meeting.

The Director discussed a new feature for participants that would require rule amendments to make it available to interlock users. The feature is listed below.

"Long Idle" means a temporary suspension of the retest timer/sequence.

This feature has been successfully implemented throughout Canada for several years without reported incident, demonstrating its efficacy and reliability.

A person may activate a Long Idle by:

- 1. Manually entering a designated code into the device model's handset; or
- 2 By using a secure mobile application provided by the manufacturer.
- 3. The maximum allowable duration for Long Idle activation shall not exceed eight (8) hours per calendar day at which point the Long Idle feature will expire.

A Long Idle shall immediately terminate:

- 1. Upon the detection of vehicle motion, or
- 2. By the person manually entering a designated code into the device model's handset.
- **6. Public Comment(s)** (pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Meetings Act, no action may be taken on any public comments)
- **7. New Business and possible action** (any matter not known about or which could not have been reasonably foreseen prior to the time of posting)

8. Chairman's Report and Adjournment

Dr. Wagner thanked the staff for their continued efforts in carrying out the Board's mission. He also thanked the members for making time to attend the special meeting, as he thought it was important for the Board to fully understand the interlock device retest sequences and possible enhancements in the future. Dr. Wagner asked for a motion to adjourn.
