
## Oklahoma's Promise 101

Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education

March 2024

#### **Application Requirements**

- Student must currently be attending the 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade
- New income limit at the time of application!
  - □\$60K AGI with 1-2 dependent children
  - □\$70K AGI with 3-4 dependent children
  - □\$80K AGI with 5 or more dependent children (there is a check for a 2nd income limit when the student starts college or career education)
- Must be an Oklahoma resident
- Deadline for the 2023-2024 school year:



### December 31 Incomplete App deadline

- June 30/July 1 remains the deadline for the initial application.
- Applications are incomplete until the income documentation is received and processed.
- December 31 of the student's senior year (prior to graduation) is the deadline for the incomplete application.



- Graduate from an Oklahoma high school (or other education program for homeschool students)
- Complete the 17 unit curriculum with at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA in these units
- Achieve at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA in overall courses for grades 9-12
- Attend school regularly
- Refrain from substance abuse
- Don't commit criminal or delinquent acts



#### Curriculum – 17 units

- 4 English
- 3 Lab Science
- 3 Mathematics
- 3 History and Citizenship Skills
- 2 Foreign or Non-English Language OR Computer Technology
- 1 Additional Unit
- 1 Fine Arts or Speech





- Pays tuition only (fees are not included) at an Oklahoma **public** college or university; a portion of tuition at an Oklahoma <u>private</u> college or university or qualified career technology programs
- Pays for the **actual hours enrolled**; recommend full-time enrollment
- May be used until the completion of a bachelor's degree, five consecutive years or at the time OKPromise has paid 129 credit hours, whichever comes first

#### **Application and Income**

- What income is counted?
- Whose income should be provided?
- Income limit \$60-70-80K or \$100K Which is correct?

#### **Income Documentation**

- Pages 1 & 2 of the parents 1040 tax form submitted to the IRS
  - ☐ Most recent tax year
  - □ Dependents must be listed if over \$60,000
- Divorce decree to confirm custody
- Untaxed income



#### **Foster Care**

■ Students in DHS custody should contact DHS for an OKPromise application at 405.522.3945.

#### Legal Guardian

- Documentation issued by a court of law authorizing legal guardianship is required
- No proof of income at the time of application



#### **Students (cont.)**

■ Undocumented Immigrant status — Students may enroll in OKPromise, however they must attain legal status before they will be eligible to receive awards in college.



#### **Adopted Students**

- Adopted Students Expanded Income Eligibility
  - > Applies only to students adopted while:
    - > In the permanent custody of Oklahoma DHS; or
    - > In the court-ordered custody of a licensed, private, non-profit child-placing agency; or
    - > In the court-ordered custody of a federally recognized Indian tribe.
  - > No initial income requirement at the time of application; proof of legal adoption required
  - > 2<sup>nd</sup> income limit levels at the time of college enrollment
    - > Birth to age 12 \$150,000
    - > Ages 13-17 \$200,000



#### **Other Issues**

- OKPromise students must meet the regular admission requirements in order to be eligible for the OKPromise award.
- Students on IEPs (language from website)
  - "... to qualify for the scholarship, the core courses completed by the student must have the same academic content and be of the same academic rigor as the regular college preparatory core courses offered by the high school in the same academic subject."





- Students may receive other aid as long as they don't exceed the cost of attendance (COA).
- It may include Pell, OTAG, other academic scholarships, fee or tuition waivers, student loans, etc.
- The OKP award may be reduced or eliminated to be sure it is within the COA.
- If received with federal aid, the student may be subject to federal regulations that limit other sources of financial aid they can receive.



#### We Need YOU!

- Continue to encourage all students to file the FAFSA.
- Families who know they won't qualify for Pell still need to file.
- If they claim that they cannot file the FAFSA, they should contact the FA director at the college they plan to attend.
- Note: 2024-25 FAFSA update.
