FY26 (2025-2026) Competitive Technology Center Lottery Grants

Attached to this memorandum is the Request for Proposal (RFP) for the 2025-2026 school year, inviting submissions for projects utilizing available Oklahoma Career Tech lottery funds. Please take note that the deadline for submission is **March 5**, 2025. The maximum award for this grant is \$50,000 per technology center.

**Submission Requirements:** A single proposal per district must be submitted as a <u>one PDF</u> document to <u>tcslotterygrants@careertech.ok.gov</u> in the following order:

- 1. Letter of Support and Sustainability on letterhead signed by the Superintendent
- 2. Technology Center Proposal Application
- 3. Budget Request
- 4. Requested supplemental documentation

**Eligibility:** Eligible Technology Centers may apply for the Competitive and Non-Competitive Technology Center Grant. Applicants can use the same application for both grants however the budget must reflect the specific expense for each grant and expenses may not be duplicated.
