Hand Sanitizer Safety





USE AT LEAST 60% ALCOHOL

If soap and water are not readily available, using a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol can help reduce the spread of germs and help you avoid getting sick. However, caution should be taken when using hand sanitizer around children.



PREVENT ACCIDENTAL POISONING

HAND SANITIZERS SHOULD BE:

- Stored out of reach and sight of children.
- ► Used with adult supervision with children ages 6 and under and with older children who have difficulty following instructions.

Swallowing more than a couple of mouthfuls of alcohol-based hand sanitizers can cause alcohol poisoning.



POISON CONTROL OR 911 FOR EMERGENCIES

IN CASE OF POISONING:

Call Poison Control, **1-800-222-1222**, if you think a child has been poisoned but they are awake and alert; the center can be reached 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Call 911 if you have a poison emergency or a child has collapsed or is not breathing.
