

Hand Sanitizer Safety



**USE AT LEAST
60% ALCOHOL**

If soap and water are not readily available, using a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol can help reduce the spread of germs and help you avoid getting sick. However, caution should be taken when using hand sanitizer around children.

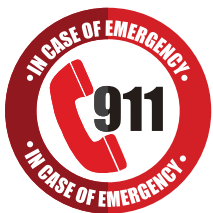


**PREVENT
ACCIDENTAL
POISONING**

HAND SANITIZERS SHOULD BE:

- ▶ Stored out of reach and sight of children.
- ▶ Used with adult supervision with children ages 6 and under and with older children who have difficulty following instructions.

Swallowing more than a couple of mouthfuls of alcohol-based hand sanitizers can cause alcohol poisoning.

OR 911 FOR
EMERGENCIES**

IN CASE OF POISONING:

Call Poison Control, **1-800-222-1222**, if you think a child has been poisoned but they are awake and alert; the center can be reached 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Call 911 if you have a poison emergency or a child has collapsed or is not breathing.
