Re: Draft Tier II Permit Modification – Change in Waste Type
North Tulsa Sanitary Landfill, Tulsa County
Solid Waste Permit No.: 3572001

Dear Mr. Hinds:

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received the Tier II Permit Modification Application (Application) to accept non-hazardous industrial waste (NHIW) for disposal on March 29, 2022. The Application was submitted by E&E Engineering and Associates, LLC on behalf of North Tulsa Sanitary Landfill (NTSL).

Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 252:515-29-2 requires NTSL to implement a Waste Exclusion Plan (WEP) to detect and prevent the disposal of prohibited wastes. NTSL submitted an updated WEP in the Application to allow for the acceptance of NHIW. NTSL submitted an additional update to the WEP to DEQ on August 3, 2023. The purpose of the update is to incorporate procedures for random load inspections for residential customers. Random load inspections for residential customers may occur at the Residential Customer Convenience Roll-Off Area near the scale house.

Pursuant to 27A O.S. § 2-14-301(A), the application “Notice of Filing” was published in *Tulsa World* on April 14, 2022. DEQ received the affidavit of publication on April 22, 2022.

The Application was determined to be administratively and technically complete and the Draft Permit Modification was issued on May 17, 2022. The “Notice of Draft Permit” was published in *Tulsa World* on June 16, 2022, initiating the 30-day comment period and opportunity to request a public meeting. DEQ received the proof of publication on June 23, 2022, meeting the 20-day requirement of OAC 252:04-7-13(d). No comments or requests for a public meeting were received.

The issuance of the Permit Modification was held due to compliance issues at NTSL. Consent Order No. 23-244 was issued on December 4, 2023. Due to the significant time elapsed since the previous public notice, please republish the “Notice of Draft Permit” and initiate a 30-day comment period and opportunity to request a public meeting.
