

Disciplinary Interview Advise of Rights for Fugitive Apprehension and Investigations

This is to advise you that you are being questioned as part of an official investigation of the Oklahoma Department of Corrections. You will be asked questions specifically directed and narrowly related to the performance of your duties or fitness for office with the Oklahoma Department of Corrections.

Employees are required to cooperate in investigations in which they will not be subject to criminal sanctions. Failure to cooperate relating to the performance of your office duties or fitness for duty during the course of an investigation may result in discipline or dismissal from the Oklahoma Department of Corrections.

If you do answer questions, neither your truthful statements nor any truthful information or evidence which is gained by reason of such statements can be used against you in any subsequent or ongoing criminal proceeding related to the subject matter of the investigation. Lying during the course of an investigation may result in criminal prosecution. 21 O.S. § 281. Additionally, these statements may be used against you for purposes of employee discipline.
