- 5. Judgments in favor of the state of Oklahoma
- 6. Judgments in favor of the United States
- 7. Other debts owed the federal, state or local governments. Debts owed the federal government may include student loans, Veterans Administration claims (e.g., home loan default, education benefit overpayment, tax liabilities, Freedom of Information and Privacy Act fees, etc.).
- 8. Other court-ordered obligations; these include restitution, alimony or other judgments against the inmate/offender.
- 9. Debts due to ODOC.
