Victim Inmate/Offender Dialogue Process

- The Community Outreach unit will meet with the inmate's/offender's facility head or designee and the facility victim liaison to review the victim inmate/offender dialogue process.
- 2. The Community Outreach unit will ensure that the inmate/offender and the victim sign the "Community Outreach Unit Consent" (DOC 090215A and DOC 090215B) upon approval by the facility head.
- 3. The community outreach coordinator will meet with the victim to review the victim inmate/offender dialogue process. The community outreach coordinator will cover the following information:
 - Victim inmate/offender orientation and preparation;
 - Sign "Consent";
 - Review expectations;
 - Review questions for the inmate/offender; and
 - Arrange a second meeting, if necessary.
- 4. The inmate/offender will participate in an Impact of Crime course at the facility, set up by the facility liaison to help prepare the inmate/offender for interaction with the victim.
- 5. The facility liaison will conduct an interview with the inmate/offender. The interview will include a simulated interview to review questions the victim would like to ask, discussion with the inmate/offender to work through answers they might provide, and an opportunity to address the inmate's/offender's questions or concerns.
- 6. The Community Outreach unit will confirm the date of the dialogue and the location of the dialogue with the facility head or designee and the facility victim liaison.
- 7. Two days before the scheduled dialogue, the facility liaison will contact the inmate/offender in person to answer any questions or concerns.
- 8. Two days before the scheduled dialogue, the Community Outreach unit will contact the victim to answer any questions or concerns.
- 9. Two days before the scheduled dialogue, the outreach coordinator will contact the facility to walk through the process and answer any questions or concerns.
- 10. The facility liaison will meet the victim at the entrance to the facility at which time, the following will occur:

- The facility liaison will introduce the victim to those assisting with the victim inmate/offender dialogue.
- The facility head or designee and the community outreach coordinator will approve individuals present during the dialogue in advance.
- The community outreach coordinator will coordinate security through the facility head or designee.
- The community outreach coordinator or facility liaison will show the victim the room and the seating arrangement in which the dialogue will take place.
- 11. The facility liaison will go over the rules for the dialogue and give the victim the choice of speaking first to the inmate/offender.
- 12. The victim, the inmate/offender, or the facility liaison can stop the process at any point if it is counterproductive.
- 13. The facility liaison will debrief the inmate/offender after completing the dialogue.
- 14. The facility liaison will debrief the victim, referring the victim to follow up with their support system.
- 15. The facility liaison will provide the dialogue evaluation form to both the victim and the inmate/offender upon completion of the dialogue.
- 16. All consent forms and evaluations will be forwarded to the Community Outreach unit for maintenance of records.
