Sexual Reoffending Behaviors

Behaviors in the following categories may be discussed monthly with the offender, depending on the offense and current issue. If any concerns arise, they will be staffed with the contain team in order to determine a response to address the issue. If no containment team is available, the concerning behaviors will be staffed with the team supervisor in order to determine a response to address the issue. **All will be documented in ICON.**

- 1. Significant social influences
- 2. Capacity for stable relationships
- 3. Emotional ID with children
- 4. Hostility toward women
- 5. General social rejections
- 6. Lack of concern for others
- 7. Impulsive
- 8. Poor problem solving skills
- 9. Negative emotionality
- 10. Sex drive/Sexual Preoccupation
- 11. Sex as coping
- 12. Deviant sexual preference
- 13. Victim Contact & Victim Access
- 14. Rejection of supervision
- 15. Substance Abuse

In depth training on all of the sexual reoffending behaviors above will be completed by all officers that supervise sex offenders on their caseload.
