| State allegations as listed on Notice of Probable Cause Hearing. |
| Note offender's admission or denial of each allegation. |
| Allow the state's representative to present evidence and witnesses, with cross examination. |
| Inform offender of existence of any confidential information. |
| Allow the offender to present evidence and witnesses, with cross-examination. |
| Determine if evidence supports Notice of Finding of Probable Cause. |
| Announce decision to offender. |
| Give offender copy of Notice of Finding of Probable Cause |
| Explain executive revocation hearing and waiver. |
| Terminate hearing. |
