

Criteria For Offering Modifications Form

The granting of a request for a Modified Driver's License is discretionary with the Department. When the department considers any request for a Modified Driver's License where the person have been given a Notice of Revocation stemming from an arrest for Driving Under the Influence or an arrest for Being In Actual Physical Control of a Motor Vehicle, the Department will ask the person requesting the Modified Driver's License to answer "**Yes**" or "**No**" as to whether or not their arrest involved any of the situations set forth on the "**Criteria For Offering Modification**" form.

If a person's arrest involved any of the set forth situations on the form, then it is likely that the Department will **not** be agreeable to granting the person a Modified Driver's License.

If a person is **denied** a Modified Driver's License by the Department, the person may appeal that decision to the district courts as provided under 47 O.S. Section 6-211.

In addition to completing the "**Criteria For Offering Modification**" form, the person seeking a Modified Driver's License will also have to complete an "**Information For Modified Driver's License**" form as part of the application process.
