Oklahoma State Statute Title 47, Section 6-107.3(A)1c, states “The Department of Public Safety shall deny a license, restricted license, or instruction permit for the operation of a motor vehicle to any person under eighteen (18) years of age who does not, at the time of application, present documentation that the person is enrolled and making satisfactory progress in a program leading to a Certificate of High School Equivalency (GED) or has obtained such certificate.
