

DECLARATION OF ELECTION EMERGENCY 2025-02

WHEREAS on April 1, 2025, a parking lot access incident occurred at a polling place in Konawa, Oklahoma, causing the need to relocate the polling place located at the Assembly of God Church located at 205 W. 3rd, Highway 39, Konawa, Oklahoma, 74849, and

WHEREAS this location serves as a polling place for Precinct 670014 in Seminole County; and

WHEREAS voting cannot occur at this location due to the parking lot being inaccessible having been recently re-surfaced and the asphalt not being fully cured.

WHEREAS the Seminole County Election Board Secretary has requested to temporarily relocate the polling place for Precinct 670014, on an emergency basis, to a location at Amy's Flowers and Gifts located at 108 N. Broadway, Konawa Oklahoma, 74849 for the election being held on Tuesday, April 1, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Paul Ziriax, Secretary of the State Election Board, pursuant to the power vested in me by Paragraph 1 of Subsection A of Section 22-101 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes hereby declare and order the following:

- 1. An election emergency exists in Precinct 670014 in Seminole County for the election being held on Tuesday, April 1, 2025.
- 2. The Secretary of the Seminole County Election Board is authorized to temporarily relocate the polling place for Precinct 670014, on an emergency basis, to Amy's Flowers and Gifts located at 108 N. Broadway, Konawa Oklahoma, 74849.
- 3. The County Election Board Secretary shall make every reasonable effort to notify the public and local news media of the relocation of the polling place for Precinct 670014.
