



At its meeting on Month Day, 20\_\_\_, the Oklahoma Ethics Commission (“Commission”) considered allegations that Candidate Campaign Committee (“Committee”) may have violated Rule \_\_\_ of the Ethics Rules, 74 O.S., Chapter 62, Appx. 1. The Commission determined there was reasonable cause to believe that violations of Rule \_\_\_ may have occurred and authorized a formal investigation into the activities of Committee.

The *Investigative Subpoena Duces Tecum* (“Subpoena”), attached hereto, is issued pursuant to the Commission’s constitutional subpoena power in Okla. Const. art. 29, § 4(c) and Rule 6.8. The Subpoena seeks information critical to a confidential, constitutionally required investigation into alleged violations of the Ethics Rules. Okla. Const. art. 29, § 4.

**RE: FY'26 Budget**

Dear Chairman Hall and Chairman Caldwell,

In response to your letter concerning a potential revenue shortfall, the Ethics Commission is prepared to accommodate a 2% budget reduction without significant difficulty. Given our relatively modest recurring appropriation, especially compared to larger agencies, and the hiring delays for new team members following our increase in appropriations at the start of FY' 26, we currently have \$22,000 available due to lower-than-anticipated personnel expenses.

As outlined in our Budget Planning Report (BPR), these unspent funds, coupled with reduced administrative costs, will suffice to absorb the 2% reduction, should it become necessary for the remainder of this fiscal year. This adjustment can be achieved without cuts or any impact on services provided. Please let me know if you have any additional questions regarding the above information.

# Guardian 2.0 Update

Report Date	Project Health	Rationale
4/4/2025	Yellow	With the delivery of data from Civix, this could be eligible to be set back to Green if RFD assesses the data is satisfactory and they can adhere to the schedule. Data migration now also affected by the issue of nightly batch exports not including all requested files.

## Key Accomplishments

Leah Leveridge submitted the completed SRS with Darci's comments addressed. Leah says *'I have completed the review of the SRS. I have addressed and resolved all of Darci's comments, and kept her edits intact to facilitate tracking. We can create a new copy edits and comments cleaned up, however for now, this is the version we would like to submit for final approval. It is attached and also in SP...'*

Discussion about Power BI licensing and pricing was held on 4/1/2025

- State plans to create an AWS instance that will be connected to RFD's AWS for Ethics.
- Power BI reports will be published to State workspace.
- Guardian 2.0 will be able to access the reports.
- OMES research indicated that embedding Power BI functions in the app is possible, but their previous attempts were abandoned. RFD intends to try this approach.
- Julie Dostal will be sending over an updated architecture diagram.
- Estimate for OMES services for one-time set up should not exceed \$4520.
- Estimate of monthly costs cover the VM, storage, application gateway, and 3 Power BI licenses (\$595.45).
- Erik will send over the 3 developers needing licenses (

Craig is engaging with Julie on the Power BI situation and thinks *'we will be back on track this week'*.

Damian (RFD) has proposed an alternative to the approach suggested by OMES for connecting the State & RFD AWS instances. Damian suggests that VPC Peering would be more cost effective and simpler to set up than a VPN connection. Jonathon (OMES) from the Cloud Network Team countered with a proposal of *'an "endpoint" using AWS PrivateLink'*. Damian responded that he did not "object" to that solution, but pointed out the costs were still higher than VPC Peering.

Civix responded to Lee Anne's questions by suggesting a meeting with Ethics and RFD. Meeting set for 4/2 at 1:30pm.

Erik has updated the tracking spreadsheet to show current project progress.

Status Meeting 4/1/2025

- Discussed Power BI and that the SOW is "coming soon."
- Ethics took on the task of ranking public reports by order of importance (in case Power BI work runs long).
- Tyler Tech:
  - No updates from Tyler
  - Jeremy reports OMES finalizing contract this week
  - RFD estimates 3-4 weeks of development are required
- RFD is preparing to submit the Requirements Sign-off Deliverable for approval.
- The Design Sign-off Deliverable is only waiting on the mockups. Once done, that deliverable will be ready to submit.

## Key Accomplishments

- Erik reinforced his biggest concerns regarding the schedule are the data migration and Power BI situations.
- Discussed the April 10 (10am) Commission meeting. Erik from RFD is confirmed. Scott is still deciding. John is also planning to attend.

Civix Meeting 4/2/2025

- Civix will provide the uploaded documents (mostly PDF, a few JPG/TIFF) by end of week as a zip file that retains the relevant file structure.
- Regarding PDFs of filings that are not stored as files, but are created on demand, Civix stated that those may (must) be extracted using the nightly batch feature of The Guardian application. This is of serious concern due to the fact that there are 10s of thousands maybe over 100,000 and there is a limit (1000) to how many can be extracted per night. PDFs were suggested as a starting point by Erik since the format changed a few years ago.
- Ethics is beginning the process to create those files.

Maxim, RFD and Ethics met 4/2/2025 to recap the Civix meeting. Raised concerns about the ability to process all the nightly batches in time for conversion.

Civix increasing the limit of nightly batch downloads from 1000 to 2500.

Maxim met with Jeremy to discuss the Power BI architecture.

Julie from OMES provided the Power BI SOW.

Ethics will upload the nightly PDF extracts to RFD's SharePoint for transfer. RFD will access them there, download to their storage and remove them from SharePoint after.

Damian (RFD) notified Ethics that they would agree to OMES proposed solution of using AWS PrivateLink to enable connectivity between RFD's AWS instance for Guardian 2.0 and the State's AWS instance used for Power BI.

RFD submitted deliverable #2 Requirements Sign-off for approval.

Ethics ran into an issue with the nightly batch download. While saying it included the 2500 files requested, it actually only included just over 50. Civix is investigating.

Jeremy was advised by OMES that *'we should have the SOW for Tyler Tech to sign by today (4/4) or possibly Monday. It is routed to Tyler to sign first'*. He has not received a response from Justin Cain with Tyler on the UAT environment setup and access.

# Consideration, Discussion, and Possible Action on Proposed Rule Change to Rule 2.69

## **Rule 2.69. One Candidate Committee at Any Time; Exception**

A candidate may have no more than one (1) candidate committee for any state office at any time; provided, however, a candidate may maintain two (2) separate candidate committees for state offices for a period of sixty (60) days after filing a Statement of Organization for a second committee. In such case, funds or debt, or both, may be transferred from the first committee to the second committee as permitted by law and these Rules.

## **Proposed Change**

A candidate may have no more than one ~~(1)~~ candidate committee for any state office at any time; provided, however, a candidate may maintain two ~~(2)~~ separate candidate committees for state offices for a period of ~~sixty (60)~~ days after filing a Statement of Organization for a second committee. A candidate shall dissolve the earlier formed candidate committee no later than 60 days following the filing of the second Statement of Organization. In such case, funds or debt, or both, may be transferred from the first committee to the second committee as permitted by law and these Rules.
