## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Oklahoma Ryan White Dental Program (ORWDP) is a comprehensive, federally funded dental access program for people living with HIV, funded under the Ryan White CARE Act.

The program is funded through the Oklahoma State Department of Health and coordinated through community based organizations and clinics.

## ELIGIBILITY

People living with HIV/AIDS qualify for the ORWDP if the individual:

- ▶ Lives in Oklahoma.
- ▶ Has a gross income of less than 500% of the federal poverty level. *(In 2024, for a one-person household, this is an annual income of less than \$75,300. This number increases in households with more people.)*



The program has specific guidelines about the services provided. Up to \$2,500 is available per year for needed services. You will not have to pay for services that ORWDP covers when you visit a participating dentist.
