- Regional Planning Committee: systems issues, trauma plan, resource assessment, board operations, education/training opportunities.......Rachel Talley REPC Chair
- No meeting held today, but we have ongoing work with individual projects.
- Robert Stewart, Director of RMRS shared an EMResource drill was conducted with Hospitals reporting 20 of 22 hospitals responded. 2 responded incorrectly and 2 did not respond. 1 is temporarily closed. EMS 17 of 32 responded correctly, 15 did not respond. RMPG next meeting today from 1p-3p. RMRS awareness trainings April 11, 2025, at Region 3 MERC in Lawton at 9 am- 3 pm. - 6. Sarah Connally, Grant Administrator if your agency needs training contact her at EMSC.
- 7. No report given Stroke System of Care. Rachel Talley gave report from the last OSSSAC/OSSCAR meeting and read from the PowerPoint they provided. She advised she would send out a copy of he PowerPoint to all the committee members after the meeting. She asked the committee to scan the QR code and take the survey that will basically ask them what stroke scale the use at their agency or facility. She also let the committee know that the OSSCAR members especially the EMS representatives have been working on the final draft of the EMS scope, education PowerPoint to distribute to all facilities that go through the education seminars. The proposed regional stroke



plans should be made available to RTABs next quarter. There will be a free interdisciplinary Statewide Stroke Conference May 1<sup>st</sup> at Moore Normant Technology Center CEU's available for healthcare professionals. TNK has been FDA approved for use in ischemic strokes as of 03/03/2025. Presented the dates, times and locations of the upcoming OSSAC and OSSCAR meetings for 2025.

- 8. Discussion, consideration, possible action and vote to......Brad LanCaster, Chair
  - RTAB meeting held quarterly or bi-annually. Mr. LanCaster let the committee know he would need discussion from the committee on whether they want to hold quarterly or bi-annal meetings. Mr. LanCaster reminded the committee that at the last OTERAC meeting the state indicated they were unsure if they would have the staff to support more that two RTABs a year. They also advised the committee the RTABs it is up to them if they want quarterly or biannual meetings. The committee discussed at length they felt that it would be difficult to get anything done with hold two meetings a year and then the officers rotate off without being able to complete what they started. Mr. LanCaster reminded the committee they are going to discuss this today and decide on whether to hold two or four meetings a year. The question was asked if the meeting could be held online. The committee was reminded that that do not allow that at this time. The rule was implemented during COVID. Someone on the committee asked if they could meet whenever they wanted and they were advised the could but if the state could not supply representation, it would be up to the committee chair and secretary to prepare the agenda and do the minutes. It was asked how could they get their agenda online and they were advised they would have to submit the agenda to the state so they could be placed online. The committee asked Mr. Graham if they went to two meetings a year could they call a special meeting to vote on rotation etc. Mr. Graham advised special meetings can be called and placed on the SOS website, but if the state is unable to provide representation, then it would be up to the committee to support the agenda and minutes to that follow open meeting guidelines. Mr. LanCaster stated he is hearing that if the state supports two meetings a year we can do informational meetings in which we discuss issues in the region and update on what the REPC and CQI have found once CQI starts back up and not have to fall under the open meetings. The meetings would only be providing information with no voting taking place. They discussed that they did not want this decision to affect RMPC meetings being they currently meet on the same days. Mr. Robert Stewart advised they could add the meeting in the RMPG meeting if the committee so decided. If we decide to go to two meetings a year the board members are on two-year terms. We can leave them at two-year terms or look at extending the terms which will take bylaws rewrite. The committee then started discussing lining up education every quarter to fill the gap on the off quarter they do not meet as an RTAB and re-evaluate at a later date. Motion was made by James Farris and seconded by Beth Malone to hold quarterly meetings

Mr. LanCaster advised those that did not receive the email to reach out to ESO and find out what they need to do.
