•	Regional Planning Committee: systems issues, trauma plan, resource assessment, board
	operations, education/training opportunitiesRachel Talley REPC Chair
	Rachel stated the committee is reviewing the trauma plan and are reviewing current plan. They
	are also requesting that the committee pushes to OTERAC that we need clarification of level 3
	hospitals in our region who attest to level 3 in order to update the trauma plan to make it more
	accurate.
	Brad LanCaster stated this is something OTERAC been a problem statewide that EMResource is
	not being updated and it is unknown to the services what assets the level 3 facilities have
	available on any given day. It has been brought to OTERAC's attention that here is what they are
	attesting to are they actually that. He states we need that data to be accurate in order to
	rewrite the trauma plan more accurately. So OTERAC has pushed it back to the RTABs chairs to
	find out how they are doing and bring that data back to OTERAC. So, in REPC this morning to
	aske the RTAB to ask the state to go back to these facilities and say this is what you are attesting
	to and verify they are meeting the requirement for their attested level. Motion was made by Tre
	McPherson and seconded by Beth Malone to recommend to OTERAC to clarify level 3 status
	through the Department of Health. Lori Smith asked for clarification of what is driving this
	question because her facility updates their information. Brad LanCaster answered that what is
	driving this request is feedback coming to OTERAC are agencies are making transport decisions
	and arriving at the level 3 facilities not have the assets they say they have. Brad advised that we
	are following the steps by going from REPC to RTAB then to OTERAC to the State. We are getting
	feedback that some facilities attesting to level 3 status are not meeting those attestations and
	asking the state to visit those facilities and verify if they are meeting those requirements they

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- Quality Improvement Committee: case reviews, trends......Brad Lancaster, RTAB Chair Brad LanCaster stated we do not have anything on that at this time. WE are going to nominate chair and vice chair today so in a few minutes we will be taking nominations on chair and vice chair so be thinking about that.
- Robert Stewart, Director of RMRS shared.

Robert Stewart gave his report on EMResource that for hospitals 12 of 21 responded which is 57%. 4 responded incorrectly; 9 did not respond; 1 is temporarily closed (Mercy Health Love County). EMS 7 of 35 responded correctly which is 20%. 25 did not respond; 3 did not answer correctly. One thing we have found out that EMResource is not being used properly. The MERC is no longer doing AAR's or MCI Drills.

RMPC the next meeting is today from 1-3pm. Education and Training coming up is as follows Cybersecurity and Extended Downtime Assessments; Resource Management; Region 3 HVA RMRS Awareness Training. As you know we no longer have a warehouse so we will have to develop a plan on how to get equipment if we need it.

HCC Redundant Communication Drill October 14 starting at 8 am to completion. - 6. Sarah Connally, Grant Administrator Not present no report.
- 7. Stroke System of Care: OSSSAC/OSSCAR, stroke plans, national. Rachel Talley Rachel stated there is a sheet out on the table and hopefully everyone grabbed one of those. It has a QR code on it. All the updates from the OSSCAR on the QR code. Please complete the survey so OSSCAR has a contact to be able for each agency and facility to send out information and get feedback. In the last meeting we worked on the final draft on stroke education for facilities and EMS agencies. Everyone is invited to the OSSAC and OSSCAR meetings. They also have a virtual way to attend. The next meeting is on October 1st at St Johns Medical Facility and will have a virtual available for that. Also, in December at OU Medical Center will be only in person. - 8. Presentation: Brain Injury Guidelines (BIG) Presented by Ms. Maryavis Howell
 Maryavis Howell introduced herself and presented the BIG process that region 7 RPC has been
 working with for about 1 year. A lot of her content comes from the current ACS guidelines. Mr.
 Howell started with statistics for traumatic brain injuries. Then went into the process they use at
 the Saint Francis in the treatment of traumatic brain injuries. She discussed the BIG 3 process they



use for the treatment of traumatic brain injuries. High risk patients need to be transported to the highest level of care. She also stated the current recommendations are to break down the GCS into individual scores and focus more on motor skills, any motor skill less than 6 need to be rapidly transported to highest level of trauma care for treatment. She provided a list of criteria with a combined total GCS score of less than 13 that need to be transported to the highest level of trauma care. She discussed considerations for the Older Adults as well as pediatric patients. She briefly discussed the standard and pediatric Glasgow coma scales. She discussed the brain injury guidelines recommended and used at Sanit Francis. She encouraged facilities and agencies to familiarize themselves with these guidelines and use them.

- Discussion of the Regions experiences with level 3's
- O Identify best practices and deficiencies to improve the system

 Chair Brad LanCaster explained that this question is coming from Dr. Teague the Chair of

 OTERAC and the committee itself are asking the regions to send back a report to OTERAC the

 experiences they are having with their level 3 facilities. What is good and what is bad and the

 weaknesses in order for the committee to gather information so they can work on best practices
 and share with the regions. Mr. LanCaster asked the committee to respond to him or Lori with
 there thoughts so they can compile a report to take back to OTERAC. He asked the committee to
 try and get those to him or Lori by the end of the month to give him time to put together a
 report to take to OTERAC.
- Improve RTAB presentation and engagement on the Education and Training Committee
- o Ensure representation from tribes, rural hospitals and air ambulance services
 Chair Brad LanCaster told the committee that we are going to try and improve our presentation
 engagement to give a true representation of hospitals and agencies. Basically, this is to see what
 the opinion of the committee is and them having input to try and help us improve the process.
 One struggle is to find good presentations. He asked the committee what they need or would
 you like to see. We want the meeting to be beneficial to the committee.
 David Graham stated they were basically talking about improving participation in the Education
 and Training Sub Committee of OTERAC. So basically, the committee is heavy on tech centers



and colleges. There is not a lot of rural agencies on the committee to let them know what is needed in the rural areas. So this is a mechanism that if you are an educator at a local facility or EMS agency we can plug you in. Because right now there are a lot of decisions that are being made that are probably putting monetary reasons and not EMS needs.

10. New Business (For matters not reasonably foreseen 48 hours prior to the meeting)

Mr. Lancaster brought up in the REPC meeting today and he wanted to remind the committee they have been working on a transfer triage piece to basically to make sure patients are being transported to the proper facility and that the transfer is managed in an appropriate manner. The original plan was to find a few facilities to go back six months and apply the two matrix's. So we are asking the EMS chief and someone from the hospital to go back 6 months and apply this matrix for transfers and see how it would affect the patient care. That was to big a task. So now we are asking for some committed hospitals and EMS agencies to pick a date and for the next 6 months meet together and apply the matrix to all transfers to see how it affects patient flow and EMS. So we need hospitals that are willing to do this and work the project forward. OTERAC is very interested in this project. So we need hospitals and EMS agencies to work on this. Mr. LanCaster asked for volunteers to work on this project. The facilities and agencies that agreed to work on this project are as follows:
