Draft Minutes

1. Tricia Fleming called the meeting to order at 1:01 pm
2. Roll Call was taken. Attendance was recorded.
3. Dr. Campbell moved to approve November 20, 2025 minutes and seconded by James Nichols. The motion passes unanimously.
4. Reports
 - Dr. Campbell reported that CQI did not meet and they are still working with the state regarding what direction they want to do with CQI and Dr. Campbell is working on a proposal to present.
 - REPC did not meet today as the chair resigned. A vote for chair and vice chair will be made today.
 - Sam Murray reported they have a Mercy medical surge exercise coming up on April 8. It will be at Pittsburg county EOC.
5. Jennifer Thompson was not here today. No update given.
6. Micheal Godwin introduced himself as the new program manager for EMSC and he reported he has been calling ED's across the state as they are making a pediatric readiness assessment survey that comes out March 3rd. It is a national program for pediatrics.
7. David Graham, Trauma Coordinator for OSDH gave an update regarding ACS, Education and Training subcommittee, Rural Health Transformation and ImageTrend updates. The ACS recommendations have 12 recommendations for the state. There is a meeting for those 12 recommendations that are broken into categories such as funding, military, trauma etc. It will be from 9am to 12 with the RTAB chairs invited as well as other key stakeholders. Once that is done there will be a follow-up meeting. There are some key areas that would like to be achieved within 90 days, with some others within 6-12 months and more complex items that would take a few years to complete. Rural Health Transformation has been meeting with Oklahoma Hospital Association and OSU and OU school of medicine to determine how the 223.5 million is going to be spent. One of the things they have been discussing is telehealth, family medicine and OB/GYN in rural areas across the state. With Education and Training Subcommittee, they are asking for more members to join that work with EMS such as hospital members, tribal members and air to further the sub committee and its goals.

ImageTrend just received the green light from OSDH for online licensing for EMS. This is a main component in compliance for EMS compact and there are 27 other states that are using ImageTrend for online licensing. The state is estimating early 2027 online licensing will be live.
