- A. Trauma Registry – The Hospital Standards for licensure, Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 310:667-59-1(b) requires Oklahoma licensed hospitals to submit trauma cases meeting inclusion criteria on a monthly basis. These cases must be entered into the Trauma Registry by the last weekday of the month following when care was rendered. For example, April cases are due the last weekday of May. Katrina Warden, Special Program Coordinator reported that several hospitals are not in compliance with reporting the trauma registry information. She provided a handout to take back to each hospital to share with the trauma registrar. She also reported to keep your contact information up to date with EMResource
- B. Russell Martin, Continuous Quality Improvement Committee, reported at the last meeting they reviewed 10 cases and sent out 10 letters, all were accepted. Jamie Lee shared with the group the new CQI decision tree that will ask for future information to help with the CQI cases. The CQI Committee is not receiving the medical records that they are requesting.
- C. Russell Martin Regional Planning Committee Acting Chair, reported that KC Nickels resigned as the RPC chair and nomination and vote to elect a new RPC chair will be conducted in the RPC meeting to follow the RTAB meeting today.
- D. Melinda Belcher, RMRS, reported t National Emergency and Public Health COVID-19 response declaration is expiring on May 11th. The RMRS will no longer be reaching out to update COVID numbers in hospitals and we will not be tracking that information. Next RMRS meeting is April 27th in person at Tulsa Health Department no virtual connection at 10:00. We are working with several agencies on exercises and drills and Ironman is coming up on May 21st.

- E. Cameron Richardson, Region 7 Stroke Liaison, reported No updates from the State regarding the Stroke Registry at the most recent OSSSAC meeting, more facilities are switching to Tenecteplase for the stroke thrombolytic of choice. If a facility hasn't already changed they likely have plans to change this calendar year, Regional stroke plans are still being developed in each region, Education opportunity: Saint Francis Trauma & Stroke Symposium 2023- Thursday September 14th Interprofessional Day and Friday September 15th Physician and Advanced Practice Provider Day
- F. Sarah Connally, Emergency Medical Services for Children reported that if your EMS agency has not received a Pedi-mate since 2016 or has been damaged you may be eligible for 3 new Pedi-mates. Dr. Lindsay DaVault, General Surgeon presented about the capabilities of rural Oklahoma where she defined rural assets and deficiencies. She discussed about the Surgical Extraction Foundation who started the (FAST) Formed Field Amputation Surgical Team. The FAST can perform field amputations or surgical manipulation to free the impinged patient. Dr. DaVault discussed how rural hospitals have limited ability of physicians, nurses, and equipment.
