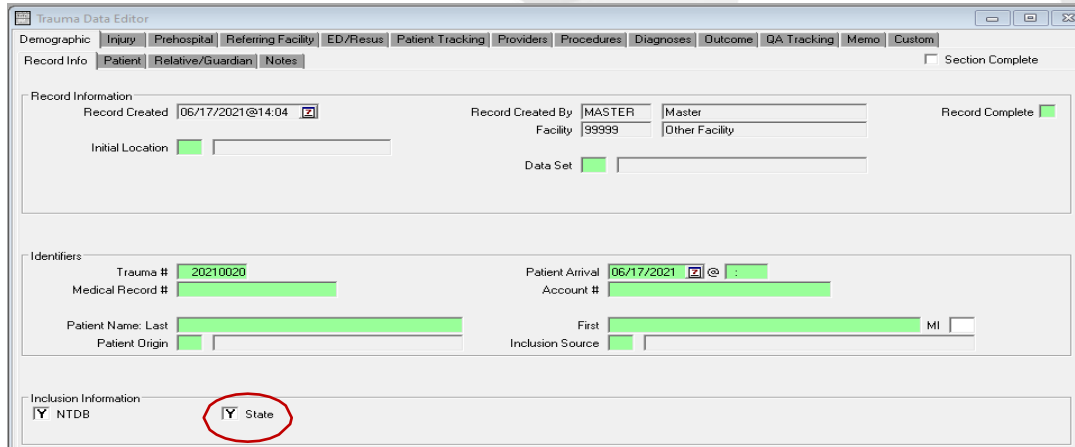

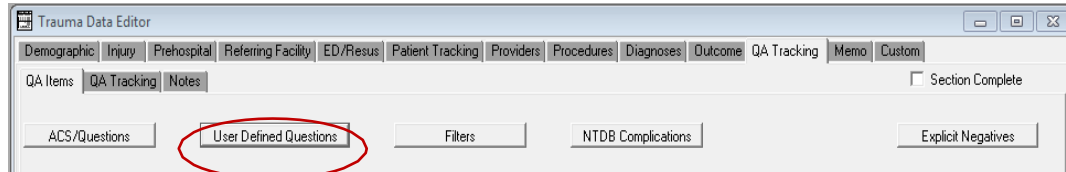
- 1) **To ensure the case is uploaded to the Trauma Registry - enter Y in the State Box for each case to be submitted to the Oklahoma Central Site.**

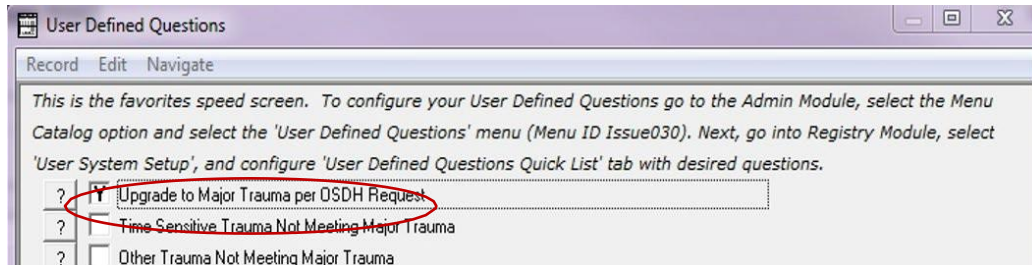
(Optional): For submission to the National Trauma Data Bank, enter Y in the NTDB box.

- 2) **All upgrades and time-sensitive cases must be clearly marked in the Trauma Registry.** To begin, click User Defined Questions.



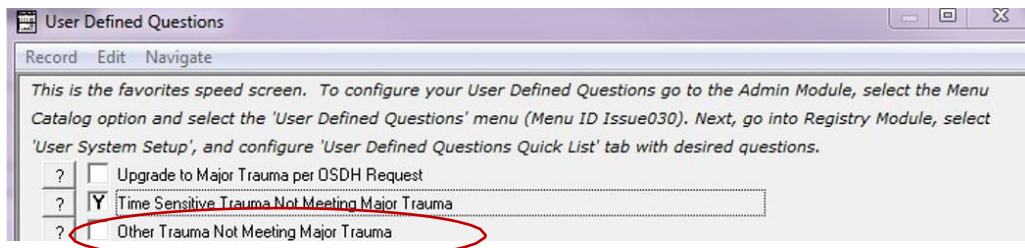
The screenshot shows the 'Trauma Data Editor' interface with the 'QA Items' tab selected. The 'User Defined Questions' button is circled in red.
