#### INTRODUCTION

This report includes substance abuse and psychiatric facility utilization data for the six month period from <u>April 2001</u> through <u>September 2001</u>. The occupancy information for this report was provided by the State Health Department, pursuant to Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 1-880.4 and 1-880.7.

The statewide occupancy rate, number of facilities, and number of beds is provided on the statewide summary page at the end of this report.

The report consists of two parts, the first part including the following information:

- county in which the facility is located;
- name of the facility;
- \* number of licensed psychiatric youth, and adult beds at the facility;
- \* number of psychiatric days, including patient service days, and reserve days for both youth and adult;
- \* psychiatric services occupancy rate (%) at the facility for the six month period for youth, adult and the two combined;
- \* number of licensed substance abuse days, including patient service days, and reserve days for both youth and adult;
- \* substance abuse services occupancy rate (%) at the facility for the six month period for youth, adult, and the two combined;
- \* occupancy rate (%) for all services at the facility for the six month period.

The second part including:

\* totals for the entire state, for youths, adults, and the two groups combined.
