MINUTES

I. Call To Order

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Eddie Sims at 11:00 am.

II. Welcome and Introductions

Jason Likens introduced Daniel King of Samaritan EMS Yukon.

III. Roll Call

Roll call was taken with the following members present: Eddie Sims; James Girvin; Celesa Green; Raquel King; and Jason Likens. No members were absent.

IV. Approval of Minutes – November 20th, 2019

A motion to approve the minutes was made by Celesa Green and seconded by Jason Likens. There was no discussion and the motion passed 5-0.

V. Business

A. Construct and possible vote to approve regional trauma and stroke capability survey for use in Regional Trauma and Stroke Plan update. Eddie Sims discussed activities regarding stroke noting that OTERAC has referred stroke discussions to the Oklahoma State Stroke System Advisory Council (OSSSAC) and explaining that the science and opinions regarding stroke has changed to include the following discussions:

- Do every patient having a large vessel stroke need to go to a comprehensive stroke center?
- Should some of the regional stroke centers be able to perform thrombectomies without having all the capabilities of a comprehensive stroke center?
- What should be done about the certified stroke centers if all patients are taken to comprehensive stroke centers and are not kept locally, causing these centers to not be able to maintain their certifications financially and operationally?

Once recommendations are made regarding the above issues, the Region 6 RPC can draft a new version of the approved regional stroke plan. Jason Likens then presented a draft regional trauma and stroke capability survey to assist in revising the regional plans for stroke and trauma. Jason will create the form and send out electronically. Results will then be sent to Emergency Systems to present at the following RPC meeting. Revisions and up to date information will assist Region 6 agencies and facilities in accurately identifying additional resources when needed. Members reviewed the proposed Regional Trauma Advisory Board Region 6 Annual Survey (see attached) and recommended the following changes:

- Addition of a request for contact information of the person completing the survey to include name, rank/title, and phone number

A motion to approve the proposed Regional Trauma Advisory Board Region 6 Annual Survey with the above changes was made by James Girvin and seconded by Celesa Green. There was no discussion and the motion passed 5-0.
