Public Library Internet Use Policy — Summary

Purpose

Our library provides public internet access to support **learning**, **research**, **and community connection**.

Use of the library's internet services implies acceptance of this policy.

We uphold the **American Library Association's Library Bill of Rights**, supporting free and open access to information.

Access

- Public computers and Wi-Fi are available to all patrons in good standing.
- Access may require a library card or guest pass.
- Time limits may apply during busy periods.
- The library cannot guarantee complete privacy or uninterrupted service.

Acceptable Use

Patrons must use internet services responsibly, ethically, and legally.

The following activities are **not permitted**:

- Viewing or sharing obscene or illegal material.
- Harassment, threats, or hate speech.
- Hacking, spreading malware, or altering library systems.
- Users must respect copyright and intellectual property laws.

Privacy & Security

- The library respects patron privacy but cannot guarantee confidentiality on public networks.
- Users are responsible for protecting personal information and logging out of accounts.
- The library complies with all applicable local, state, and federal laws.

Filtering & Children's Access

- In compliance with the **Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA)**, filtering software limits access to inappropriate content on youth computers.
- Parents or guardians are responsible for monitoring their children's internet use.
- Staff provide guidance but cannot supervise individual sessions.

Staff Assistance

- Staff offer basic help with internet and computer use as time permits.
- The library may provide **digital literacy workshops** to promote safe and effective online use.

Enforcement

- Violations may result in loss of computer or library privileges.
- Illegal activities may be reported to law enforcement.
- Enforcement is fair, consistent, and in line with library policy.

Liability

The library is **not responsible** for:

- Loss or damage to data, files, or devices.
- Accuracy or reliability of online information.
 Use the internet at your own risk.

Policy Review

This policy is reviewed **every four years** or as needed.
