ELIGIBILITY

Books must have been published originally between January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025. Entries are sent to judges upon receipt, so please enter as soon as possible.

- Any individual, organization, or company may enter in any appropriate category.
- Books considered for this award must have an Oklahoma-based theme, or entrants (authors, illustrators, photographers, or book designers) must live or have lived in Oklahoma.
- Books—hardcover or paperback—entered in previous Oklahoma Book Award competitions are not eligible.

JUDGES

A panel of judges will consider all entries. Judges will grant awards at their discretion. Judges represent a variety of backgrounds including writers, educators, librarians, graphic artists, and readers. Entries in all categories (except the Book Design/Illustration or Photography category) are principally judged on the quality of writing, with organization and interpretation also playing a role in the decision.

Entries must be received by January 7, 2026. Finalists will be announced in Spring 2026, and winners will be announced at the awards ceremony in the spring.
