As of the date of this meeting, there were 267 submitted applications, with 147 of those having been reviewed. Fifty of the applications have been approved. The average processing time from the time an application is considered complete to issuance of the independent prescriptive authority recognition is 1.5 days. There have been questions from applicants on the continuing education requirement relating to what is acceptable to meet requirements, as well as additional staff time evaluating what is submitted to ensure the eligibility criteria is met.

The agency continues to work with OMES REALS and Oklahoma Correctional Industries (OCI) on securing additional office space and furniture in efforts to accommodate return of the two Peer Assistance Program case managers to the office. The additional office space is pending.
