

**Minutes of the  
Oklahoma Corporation Commission  
State of Oklahoma**

**September 9, 2025 – 1:30 p.m.**

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission's ("Commission") regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on September 9, 2025, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission's website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 3:00 p.m., September 5, 2025, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. The notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission's website, [Oklahoma.gov/occ](http://Oklahoma.gov/occ). A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Chairman David called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiett, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

The following items were taken up out of order from the posted agenda schedule.

**Approval of minutes of prior meeting(s)** Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Garey Wortham, commission secretary, to present the minutes for approval. The Commissioners unanimously approved the minutes for August 20, 2025, at 1:30 p.m., August 27, 2025, at 1:30 p.m., and September 2, 2025, at 1:30 p.m.


**New Business** There was no new business.
