

**Minutes of the
Oklahoma Corporation Commission
State of Oklahoma**

January 7, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on January 7, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 1:00 p.m., January 6, 2026, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. The notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, Oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Commissioner David called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiatt, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Consideration of and possible vote(s) on proposed or potential orders in cases on the daily signing agenda docket. The Commission may discuss and consider alterations, revisions, or amendments to the proposed or potential orders. (Votes may be taken on individual cases, on the daily signing agenda docket as a whole, or both by individual cases and the remaining docket. Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Garey Wortham, commission secretary, to present the items for approval. Mr. Wortham announced that Commission staff requested to strike the proposed orders for Case No. CD2025-000742 and Case No. CD2025-003159. The Commissioners unanimously approved the remaining proposed orders, with the exception of Commissioner Hiatt not participating in the issuance of the proposed orders for Case No. CD2025-000298 and Case No. CD2025-000299.

Commissioner David opened the floor for public comment. Public comment was taken from multiple persons present in Suite C50 and from multiple persons online. Mr. Argenbright recommended that the Commission close the Notice of Inquiry and issue the proposed Order Closing NOI. Discussion was held.
