

**Minutes of the
Oklahoma Corporation Commission
State of Oklahoma**

January 21, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on January 21, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 11:00 a.m., January 20, 2026, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. The notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, Oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Commissioner David called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiatt, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.
