


Who we are


Our utility service areas





Percent of connections



Customer connections





IIJA: Electric Vehicles

- Awaiting OK EV State plan submission (Due August 1)
- Participated in the Oklahoma Electric Vehicle Coalition meetings
- Will review the Oklahoma State NEVI plan when completed to determine how Liberty can assist the state in implementing the plan



IIJA: Cybersecurity

- IIJA cybersecurity funding under review for appropriate overlap with Liberty priorities
- Federal program and cybersecurity standards development will present opportunities to Private Industry Critical Infrastructure owners and operators
- Smart Grid Investment Grant Program (\$3 billion): application process expected to be open by end of 2022
- Energy Sector Operational Support for Cyber Resilience Program (\$50 million): New program, timing TBD
- Used to expand DOE cooperation with the intel community in the energy sector, enhance Electricity Information Sharing and Analysis Center



IIJA: Grid Resiliency

- Grid Resilience Formula Program: \$7.6 million for Oklahoma
 - Distribution for sub-grantees not yet determined
- Competitive grants for grid resiliency:
 - Section 40101(c) Preventing Outages and Enhancing the Resilience of the Electric Grid - \$500 million Section
 - Section 40103 Electric Grid Reliability and Resilience, Research, Development, and Demonstration - \$5 billion
 - Section 40107 Deployment of Technologies to Enhance Grid Flexibility (expansion of the Smart Grid Investment Matching Grant Program) - \$3 billion
