NOTES:

1. 1016 forms cannot be processed until an OCC-approved 1002A is on-file.
2. 1016 forms are required only when requesting a capable allowable (an allowable in excess of the minimum allowable, which is currently set at 3,000 mcf/day).
3. A properly completed, OCC-approved 1002A form will establish a minimum allowable, unless superseded by a capable allowable established by a 1016 test. If a 1016 expires and a new 1016 is not filed, the well will revert back to a minimum status.
4. If there are two or more 1016 forms that present an "overlap" of conflicting allowables, the 1016 form with the higher AOF will prevail in the period of the overlap.
5. Staff will verify test calculations, review for accuracy and completeness, and assign an appropriate allowable based on current testing and proration rules, and relevant OCC orders.
6. The 1016 form will be publicly viewable on OCC's imaging system after all processing has been completed.
