SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT RULE CHANGES* EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2023

[OAC 165:15] No major changes. Added 50-gallon prover to the tolerance list in Appendix A.

[OAC 165:16] No major changes. Updated standards, codes, and specifications to the current edition.

[OAC 165:25-1-53(d)] Copies of records must be readily available to Fuel Specialists, or they can be emailed and received by Fuel Specialists before the inspection is completed.

[OAC 165:25-1-53(d)(8)] Added walkthrough inspections, spill and overfill testing, and containment sump testing to the list of EPA's 2018 operation and maintenance records that owners must maintain for 3 years.

[OAC 165:26-1-110 and 165:26-110.1] PSTD split the current license for AST Licensees into a separate license for AST installers and removers. Current license holders will automatically split and will not have to retest when their license comes up for renewal at the end of the year as long as the renewal fee for both licenses is paid. If fees are not paid and the licenses lapse, they would have to retest.

[OAC 165:26-2-1.1] An AST Installer must be present at all times during the installation of aboveground storage tank systems.

[OAC 165:26-2-191] Repairs to an aboveground storage tank system must be performed by an AST Installer.

[OAC 165:26-2-210)] An AST Remover must remove aboveground storage tank systems.

[OAC 165:26-2-213] An AST Remover must be on site at all times during the removal of an AST system.

[OAC 165:27] No major changes. Deleted language that repeated what was already in the statutes and removed PSTD's fax number from the rules.

[OAC 165:29] No major changes. Clarified TPH action levels when activating a release case and removed PSTD's fax number from the rules.
