AGENDA ITEM 1 – CALL TO ORDER, INTRODUCTIONS AND ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Chair Lise Trudeau (MNPUC) called the meeting to order at 8:30 AM Central Time and a quorum was established. It was noted that Walt Cecil (MO PSC) would hold proxy for Adam McKinnie (MO PSC) from 12:30 pm -2:30 pm and Chris Hanson (ND PSC) would hold proxy for Victor Schock (ND PSC) from 8:00 am -8:30 am.

AGENDA ITEM 2 – CONSENT AGENDA

MOTION: To approve the Consent Agenda. Cindy Ireland (APSC) motioned / Shawnee Claiborn-Pinto (PUCT) seconded. *Passed unanimously*.

AGENDA ITEM 3 – ACTION ITEMS

Angela Sartori (SPP Staff) provided an update on Action Item 182, indicating that an update would be provided during the meeting and the RSC would receive a status update at the upcoming Education Session.

Chair Trudeau (MNPUC) stated that the group would also be receiving an update on HITT C1 during the meeting.

AGENDA ITEM 4 – FERC UPDATE

Justin Hinton (SPP Staff) provided an update on several FERC filings:

- 1. PBA ELCC docket a filing had been made by the Market Monitoring Unit related to the sufficiency valuation curve calculation. SPP is reviewing the filing and will likely file a response.
- 2. Fuel Assurance docket there were several comments and protests filed. SPP is reviewing and will file a response.
- 3. Winter/Summer PRM the draft filing is going through the internal review process and should be filed soon.





- 4. Safe Harbor Provisions on September 26, 2024, FERC issued a Letter Order accepting the provisions.
- 5. MDU/Charlie Creek Complaint, Docket No. EL24-61 FERC issued an Order denying the complaints.

AGENDA ITEM 5 – RESOURCE ADEQUQCY

- a. <u>Supply Adequacy Working Group</u> Chris Haley (SPP Staff) provided a brief update on SAWG work plan for the remainder of 2024 and 2025-2026.
- b. <u>REAL Team</u> Shawnee Claiborn-Pinto (PUCT) provided an update on REAL Team activities. Ms. Claiborn-Pinto reviewed the high priority items which include demand response, long-term planning reserve margin, long-term resource mix, and generation interconnection.

AGENDA ITEM 6 – ACTION ITEMS FROM HITT C1 DISCUSSION

Charles Locke (SPP Staff) reviewed the action items from the September CAWG meeting related to HITT C1. Mr. Locke made a terminology clarification stating that the "Wind Allocation Rule" will be referred to as the "Delivery Point Rule" going forward. The working group closed out the action item regarding cost caps on Attachment AQ upgrades. An action item was established to continue the fuel neutrality and Delivery Point Rule discussion and conduct a straw poll at the November CAWG meeting.

AGENDA ITEM 8 – CONGESTION HEDGING UPDATE

Micha Bailey (SPP Staff) provided an update on the recent developments from the Market Working Group (MWG). Mr. Bailey reviewed the motions voted on at the recent MWG meeting. The MWG voted to defer evaluation until post 2025-2026 TCR period to evaluate other changes related to RR591.

SPP Staff plans to work with stakeholders to understand concerns and bring a policy forward for RSC consideration in February 2025.

AGENDA ITEM 9 – CPPTF UPDATE

John Krajewski (NPRB) provided an introduction on this agenda item stating there are still major decisions to be made around how to calculate the network upgrade charge. Sunny Raheem (SPP Staff) discussed Option 2, the Analytical Approach to estimating a long-term cost contribution from generator interconnection customers to the long-term portfolio and reviewed the safeguards and NRIS+ incremental upgrades.

AGENDA ITEM 11 – NEW PROVISIONAL LOAD UPDATE

Jason Speer (SPP Staff) provided additional education on the Provisional Load Process stating that this is designed for transmission customers that do not have enough network resources to cover their 10-year load forecasts. Mr. Speer compared this process to the AQ process and provided cost allocation examples. Pending MOPC approval of this policy, a draft revision request will be developed and discussed within the appropriate working groups in November and December





2024. MOPC consideration of the RR is anticipated in January 2025. SPP Staff volunteered to do outreach to determine what additional information is needed by CAWG members to move this policy forward.
