Notice of Intent to Construct a Wind Farm in Woodward and Dewey Counties, Oklahoma

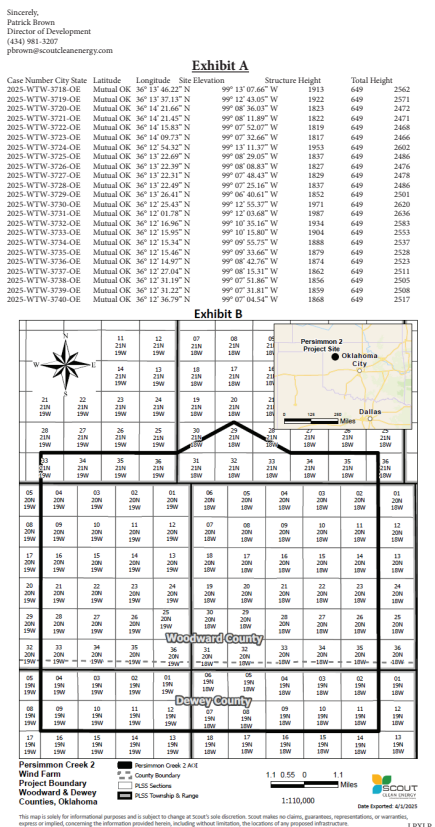
In order to comply with the requirements of Section 17-160.20-21 of the Oklahoma Wind Energy Development Act ("Act"), and pursuant to Oklahoma Administrative Code 2348-3-1(a), the owner of a wind energy facility shall submit to the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("OCC") and the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission ("OAC") copies of all Notice of Proposed Construction ("7460-1 Form") with the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA"), for any individual wind turbines or any other individual structure that requires a 7460-1 Form that is part of a wind energy facility.

This submission is being provided to the OCC and the OAC within thirty (30) days of the initial filing with the FAA of the initial 7460-1 Form for turbine locations that are a part of the Permian Creek Wind Farm 2, which is to be located in Woodward and Dewey Counties, Oklahoma (the "Project"). Enclosed as Exhibit A to the Project is a map depicting the Project boundary is included with this Notice as Exhibit B. As of the date of this Notice, and based on publicly available data, we confirm that the Project design complies with the setback requirements set forth under section 17-160.20(A) of the Act.

In accordance with Section 17-160.21 of the Oklahoma Wind Energy Development Act, the Project confirms it is submitting a copy of this notice to the OCC and the OAC within thirty (30) days of the initial filing with the FAA of the initial 7460-1 Form for turbine locations that are a part of the Permian Creek Wind Farm 2, which is to be located in Woodward and Dewey Counties, Oklahoma (the "Project"). Enclosed as Exhibit A to the Project is a map depicting the Project boundary is included with this Notice as Exhibit B.
