#### SUMMARY:

The proposed emergency rule revisions include a requirement for all residential level of care providers certified under Chapter 18 to provide access to medication assisted treatment, changes to requirements for treatment hours of dependent children in residential and halfway house facilities, and the addition of language that describes the Certificate of Need assessment process applicable to certain newly certified providers intending to enroll as a Medicaid provider.
