


How To Apply for An OKDOT Route Approval Online

The primary objective of Route Approval is to streamline the process for carriers in obtaining multiple permits, which would typically necessitate GK or third-party routing. If a carrier anticipates the need to transport the same load multiple times within a 30-day period, Route Approval enables them to secure the necessary permits more efficiently, eliminating the repeated wait times associated with GK or third-party approvals.

1. Navigate to <https://permitmanager.okladot.state.ok.us/okiepros> and enter your user credentials.
2. Click "Login"

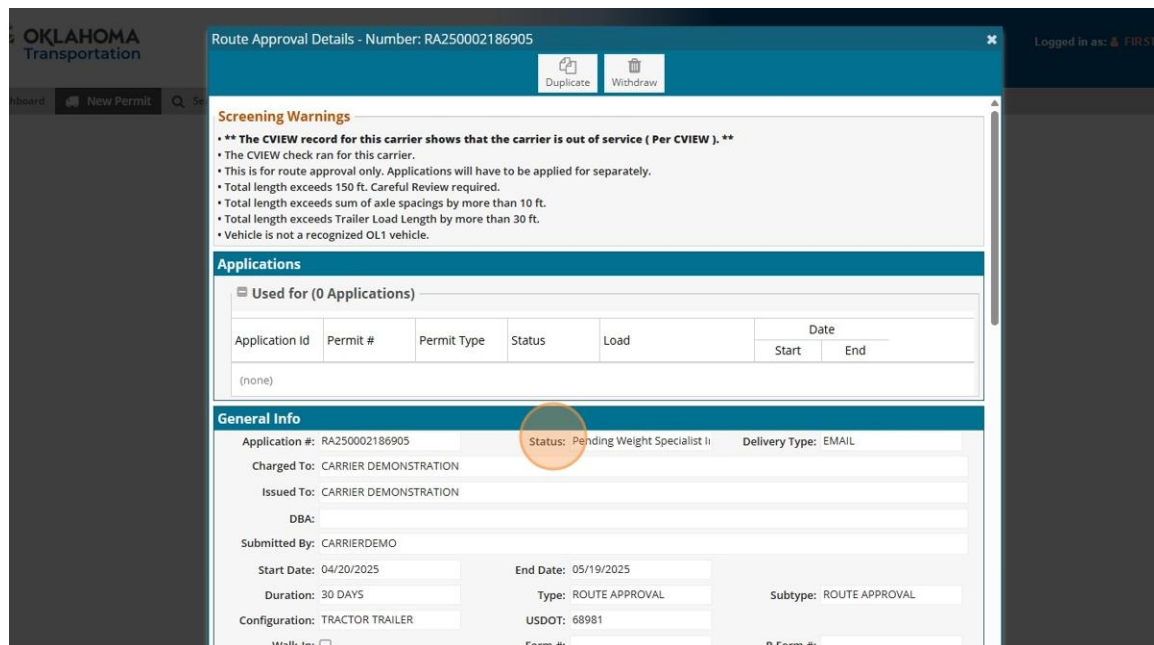
