

# **How To Apply for An OKDOT Route Approval Online**

The primary objective of Route Approval is to streamline the process for carriers in obtaining multiple permits, which would typically necessitate GK or third-party routing. If a carrier anticipates the need to transport the same load multiple times within a 30-day period, Route Approval enables them to secure the necessary permits more efficiently, eliminating the repeated wait times associated with GK or third-party approvals.



- 2. Click "Login"





8. Select the appropriate Subtype from the dropdown menu: Oversize/Overweight or Overweight




9. Enter Oversize (if applicable) and Overweight information of the vehicle (See example below)






### 16. Click Permit Details to review the Route Approval application



17. Note that Status field will indicate it is pending review.





18. Once the Route Approval application has been through 3<sup>rd</sup> party review and approved by OKDOT, the application's status will change to ACTIVE. Users can now use the Route Approval to create real permit applications to carry loads along the route with the approved vehicle and load.



19. Select Create From at the top of the Active Route Approval or select the Add New button under the Route Approval's Applications section.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: To utilize the approved route, please ensure you create your permits directly from the active Route Approval. This will ensure that all route restrictions and overrides are correctly applied. When duplicating a previous permit application, the approved route will not automatically be transferred.


