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1.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) held an in-person open house public meeting for SH-9 in McIntosh County. The bridge and approaches project on SH-9 over Flat Rock and Wallace Creeks, is located 6.0 and 6.2 miles east of junction of SH-52 in McIntosh County. The purpose of the open house public meeting was to present the proposed design for these two bridge replacement projects. The purpose of the project is to correct a bridge that is at risk of becoming structurally deficient over Flat Rock Creek and a structurally deficient bridge over Wallace Creek.

The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) document was approved on December 16, 2022.

The in-person open house public meeting was held October 12, 2023, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Eufaula Community Center in Eufaula. The preliminary project design was available for viewing on large aerial exhibit so participants could view the project. There was no formal presentation. Staff were available at the open house public meeting to answer questions.

The open house public meeting had six (6) participants that signed into the open house public meeting, no phone calls were received, one (1) citizen written comments was received, and one (1) public officials' comment was received.

2.0 INTRODUCTION

This document summarizes an in-person open house public meeting conducted for a bridge and approaches project on SH-9 over Flat Rock and Wallace Creeks, located 6.0 and 6.2 miles east of junction of SH-52 in McIntosh County. The purpose of the open house public meeting was to present the proposed design for these two bridge replacement projects. The purpose of the project is to correct a bridge that is at risk of becoming structurally deficient over Flat Rock Creek and a structurally deficient bridge over Wallace Creek

The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) document was approved on December 16, 2022.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing to replace two bridges on SH-9 over Flat Rock Creek and Wallace Creek. The existing SH-9 roadway has two (2) 12 foot wide paved driving lanes with 5 foot wide paved shoulders. In this area, the SH-9 roadway curves through the two bridge locations.

The proposed roadway improvement through both bridge areas consists of two (2) 12 foot wide paved driving lanes with 8 foot wide paved shoulders. An offset roadway alignment to the north is planned near Flat Rock Creek which improves the roadway geometry through the existing curve. A detour to the south, near NS-4060 Road is needed due to the intersection and Flat Rock Creek bridge location. An offset alignment to the south along with a shoo-fly to the south near Wallace Creek will avoid impacts to wetlands on the north side of SH-9 near Wallace Creek.

The Flat Rock Creek bridge will be replaced with a 40 foot clear roadway width span bridge on an offset alignment to the north. The Wallace Creek bridge will be replaced with a 100 foot long reinforced concrete box on an offset alignment to the south. New right-of-way will be required. The road will remain open during construction.

3.0 OPEN HOUSE PUBLIC MEETING

3.1 MEETING NOTIFICATION

Thirteen (13) property owners and three (3) utility owners were identified adjacent to the study area, which is largely rural and with scattered residential homes. These owners were notified of the in-person open house public meeting by postcard mailed October 4, 2023.

Twenty-nine (29) invitation letters to the public meeting were mailed to various agencies and members of the public on October 4, 2023. The public officials meeting invitation list included ODOT Commissioners, McIntosh County Commissioners, State and U.S. elected officials, Eastern Oklahoma Development District, Eufaula Public School, Eufaula Police and Fire Departments, and Tribal Nations.

A copy of the postcard, public official letter and the mailing lists are included in **Appendix A**.

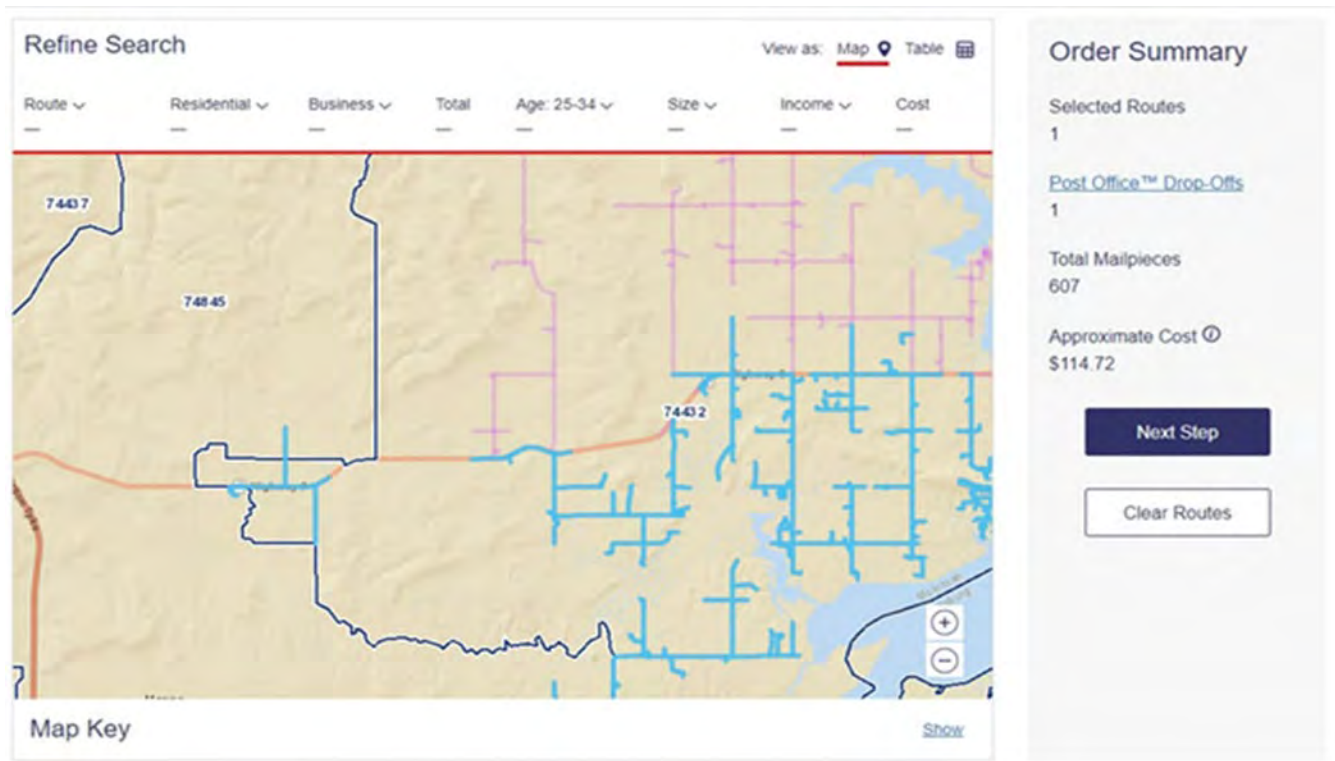
3.2 OUTREACH

Outreach was provided by direct mailing by the post office to one (1) mail delivery route along the project area as noted in blue in map 1 below. Six-hundred and seven (607) postcards were printed and mailed by Mercury Press Plus and direct mailed to the Post Office for distribution to routes.

Direct mailing of pamphlets helps to ensure that individuals who are leasing property within the study area will get the information, as well as the property owners receiving notification through the mail. As the postal route serves a larger area, more people who use the SH-9 roadway received the information, increasing the opportunity for input.

3.3 MEETING INFORMATION AND FORMAT

The in-person open house public meeting was held October 12, 2023, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Eufaula Community Center, located at 121 High Street in Eufaula.

Six (6) residents attended the open house. Large signs were displayed during the meeting to direct citizens to the meeting location. The preliminary project design was available for viewing on a large aerial display so participants

could view the roadway improvements Hudson Prince, HUB and ODOT staff (six total) were available for discussions with members of the public. There was no formal presentation.

All comments were requested to be received on or before October 19, 2023. Written comments could be submitted by mail or email.

4.0 COMMENTS

4.1 COMMENTS RECEIVED AT PUBLIC MEETING

A summary of the comments received from the open house public meeting is provided below.

Summary of Citizen Comments Received

- A property owner, to the north before the first bridge, commented on witnessing several wrecks and one fatality near the bridges. The district explained the alignment, and the shoofly's needed during construction. The construction timing was explained and how ODOT is only allowed to cut trees down during certain times of the year due to bats. How ODOT handles replacing fences was discussed. Flooding and debris in the creeks were discussed and it was mentioned that the span bridge over Flat Rock Creek will help with flooding and debris issue.
- A contractor who sells bridge beams attended the meeting and spoke to the designer.
- A property owner asked about construction details and having 2-lane detours.
- A citizen asked about county roads and funding.

4.2 PHONE CALL COMMENTS

No phone calls were received.

4.3 WRITTEN COMMENTS

One (1) written comment was received from the open house meeting. This comment is listed in the table below. An ODOT response has been added at the end of each general category. Copies of the citizen written comments are included in **Appendix C**.

Additionally, The Caddo Nation would need to be notified of an inadvertent discovery within 24 hours.

This comment is noted and ODOT Cultural Resources Program has plans in place if an inadvertent discovery occurs during construction.

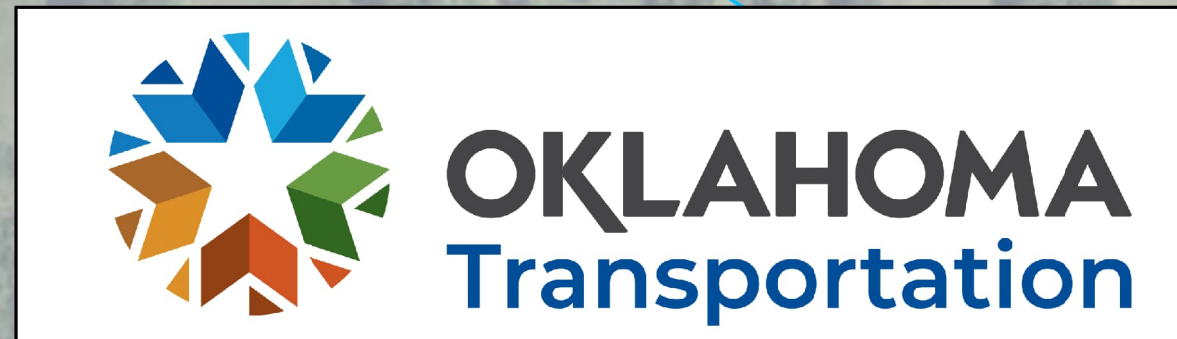
