Dear Secretary Buttigieg:

We are pleased to write this letter in support of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation's (ODOT) application for the Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant (MPDG) program. This project would provide crucial improvements to the Roosevelt Memorial Bridge on US-70 over Lake Texoma.

The Roosevelt Bridge over Lake Texoma connects Southern Oklahoma from east to west. Originally built in 1942 under the Roosevelt Administration, the bridge has become functionally obsolete and is currently at-risk of falling into poor condition and becoming structurally deficient. The bridge carries 8,500 vehicles per day, and while either side of the bridge is a four-lane highway, the bridge continues to be two lanes with no shoulders which leads to bottlenecks and higher rates of collisions. ODOT anticipates traffic volumes to increase to over 27,000 per day by 2050 and the current bridge is simply insufficient to provide for existing and future traffic needs. Additionally, with the Roosevelt Bridge crossing one of Oklahoma's largest lakes, flooding has become common which has forced past closures lasting several days.

Building upon prior investment by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), ODOT proposes to provide a safe crossing of Lake Texoma that meets all current design criteria, accommodate future traffic demands, and improve the efficiency and reliability of the movement of people and freight. Additional accommodations will focus on increasing resiliency, providing a new bicycle and pedestrian crossing, and consideration of innovative project delivery methods. The completion of this project will improve the National Highway System and ensure that major freight routes continue to serve our nation's economy.

Thank you in advance for your strong consideration of ODOT's application for the MPDG program. Please contact our offices if you need any further assistance as you consider this important proposal.

On behalf of the Southern Oklahoma Development Association (SODA), a ten-county economic development district located in southern Oklahoma, we would like to express our support for the Oklahoma Department of Transportation's (ODOT) 2023/2024 MPDG application for the Roosevelt Bridge: US-70 over Lake Texoma.

The US-70 Roosevelt Bridge across Lake Texoma between Kingston and Durant is functionally obsolete and at-risk of falling into poor condition and becoming structurally deficient. The proposed project will provide a safe crossing of Lake Texoma that meets all current design criteria, accommodate future traffic demands, improve the efficiency and reliability of the movement of people and freight, increase resiliency, provide a new bicycle and pedestrian crossing, and consider innovative project delivery methods such as accelerated bridge construction and progressive design build.

US-70 is an important link on the National Highway System (NHS) and provides critical east-west connectivity across southern Oklahoma, linking major freight routes such as I-35, US-69, and US-75. The existing two-lane facility is not sufficient to accommodate the anticipated future traffic growth. Adding traffic capacity to the Roosevelt Bridge presents a significant complication. Lake Texoma is one of the largest lakes in Oklahoma and is nearly 100 feet deep at this location.

Without improvements the level of Level of Service on US-70 is anticipated to worsen and result in significant congestion. The additional two lanes planned as part of the Roosevelt Bridge Project will improve safety and Level of Service on the bridge, removing the bottleneck created by the existing two-lane facility.






