QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q 1: Is the supplier required to provide a COI for Worker's Compensation Insurance at the time of the bid submittal? Page 2- Question 6 states to provide it with the bid. However, on page 9, section A.26 states that the successful supplier(s) *awarded* the contract shall obtain insurance. Please clarify.

A 1: Yes, the COI is due at the time of bid submittal.

Q 2: Are we required to bid all line items to be considered responsive?

A 2: No, you are not required to bid on all line items to be considered responsive.

Q 3: Can OKDOT provide the pricing sheet in Excel format?

A 3: Please see the attached Excel pricing sheet (includes two tabs).

Q 4: Would OKDOT consider waiving the B.17. Testing for Conformance sample requirement for incumbent manufacturer contract holders that sell the same material on contract, annually certify to Oklahoma's Qualified Product List (QPL), and remain compliant with Oklahoma's specifications?

A 4: ODOT will not waive the requirement as the requirement references "Items may be tested". An incumbent vendor would not need to be tested.

Q 5: Similarly, would OKDOT waive the C.4. Obligations and Requirements for incumbent manufacturer contract holders that sell the same material on contract and have previously submitted the Traffic New Product Evaluation (TNPE, current version dated 07/31/2017) form for each item in the proposal, which remains unchanged?

A 5: Yes, incumbent vendors do not need to resubmit their products for the QPL.
