

# Use Zoom to Attend Your Meeting Remotely

Child Support Services will provide you information on how to join the meeting by phone or video. This page provides instructions to join using the Zoom desktop, and mobile device, video software.

You can use your telephone to join a meeting without video. Call the phone number given to you and put in the meeting ID and password. Then, you will be connected to the meeting.

## Zoom Help Center

When you choose a link to a Zoom meeting, you will be prompted to download and install Zoom to your device. The best thing to do is plan ahead. Decide how you want to join the meeting: with a laptop, a tablet, or a smartphone.

Go to the Zoom **Download Center** at <https://zoom.us/download> to install the app on your computer or mobile device.

The Zoom Help Center discusses how to join a meeting through an email invite, an instant messaging invite, from the browser, from the Zoom desktop and mobile application, from a landline or mobile phone, and with a H.323 or SIP device. There is also a video overview available.

Each meeting has a unique 9, 10, or 11-digit number called a **Meeting ID** that will be required to join a Zoom meeting.

If you are joining via telephone, you will need the teleconferencing number provided in the invite.
