
SoonerCare Members

The number (prevalence) of SoonerCare members with depression fell from 123,904 (8.4%) in SFY2023 to 116,537 (7.6%) in SFY2024.


The majority of these were age 21-25, but this is not primarily a condition of any one age group.

In SFY2024 there were

116,537 members with depression, or 7.6% of all members

38.4% were 21 - 45 44,715 members





Members with Depression by Qualifying Group SFY2024













SoonerCare Members with Depression

In SFY2024, depression was more prevalent among adults, females, and Caucasians than would be expected based on the demographic composition of all SoonerCare members. See details below. The black line represents the percent of total SoonerCare members.

Reimbursement Cost

The total reimbursement for members with depression increased from \$2,090,791,742 in SFY2023 to \$2,226,841,573 in SFY2024. This is not due to an increase in number of SoonerCare members with depression, which fell between SFY23 and SFY24.

This increase in total reimbursement was also associated with an increase in per-member reimbursement from \$17K to \$19K per year.

The graph below illustrates how the percentage of reimbursement for services rendered for members with depression is disproportionately higher than the prevalence of members without depression.





SoonerCare Members with Depression: Percent of Total Reimbursement Compared to Percent of Total SoonerCare Enrollment


